ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- a) **B.Ed.**
- Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's degree or any other qualification declared equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme. Any candidate with 49.9% or less marks would not be eligible.
 - The reservation of SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government / State Government, whichever is applicable. There shall be a relaxation of 5% marks in favour of SC/ST/OBC and other categories of candidates. Candidate with 44.9% marks or less would not be eligible.
** Added vide Para 3.2 of Appendix IV of N.C.T.E. Notification No. F-51F1/2007-N.C.T.E. (N&S) dated 27-11-2007.
 - Candidate must have studied the major subject of the subject combination for at least three years at Bachelor's level/Master's level. Honours students shall opt for major subject in which they have obtained Honours, the minor subject should have been studied at least for one year.
- b) **M.A. Education** – B.Ed / B.A. with Education Subject [Gen. – 50%, Reserved Category – 45%]
c) **Inclusive Education** – +2 [Gen. – 50%, Reserved Category – 45%]
d) **Guidance & Counselling** – B.Ed. [Gen. – 50%, Reserved Category – 45%]

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

- The duly filled admission form with four PP size photographs, one pasted on the form and three other attached with the form, should be submitted on admission.
- Students from other Universities will have to submit Migration Certificate within 30 days of their admission to the college.
- A student has to bring the following original certificates during the admission
 - Martic Certificate as a proof of DOB.
 - DMC of all classes passed from Board / University.
 - Character Certificate of the last institute attended.
 - Proof reserved category.
- The attested copies of the above mentioned certificates have to be attached with the admission form.
- Admission form has to be filled neatly without any cutting. Incomplete form will not be considered.

FEE STRUCTURE

The fee structure will be as prescribed by Punjabi University, Patiala. Other rules regarding fee :-

- Fees once paid will not be refundable.
- If a student does not attend the college within 10 days from the start of classes, his/her admission will stand cancelled.
- A late fee of Rs. 5/- per day shall be charged.
- All dues must be cleared before the issue of Uni. Roll No. slip for the final exam.
